- 2. **Public Right of Way -Issues** A resident has reported issues with antisocial behaviour relating to a public footpath in Springvale. The Parish Council are in the process of installing CCTV to help tackle antisocial behaviour and suggest contacting The Neighbourhood Watch, the PCSO and Borough Councillors for advice.
- 3. Parish Council Community Cost of Living Grant Scheme The Parish council received information regarding a Cost-of-Living Grant Scheme from our Local Council Association but unfortunately applications for the grant scheme expires in May. Council members advised the Clerk to ask if an extension could be granted, and if so, advertise the scheme in the village newsletter and on Facebook pages. Keep on the agenda.

- 4. **Kent Plan Tree Call for Sites** Kent County Council are bidding for funding to focus on planting and natural colonisation of trees in areas outside of woodlands and are looking for areas of land from the size of a tennis court up to about half a football pitch.
